

Medical & Prevention

- Survivors are highly encouraged to seek confidential medical care after any assault.
- Evidence collection by a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) is available at no cost.
- Preventative medication for sexually transmitted infections and/or pregnancy is available.
- Evidence can be collected without reporting and is valid for up to five years.

Counseling & Advocacy

- All students affected by sexual or intimate partner violence are encouraged to file reports.
- Office of Civil Rights & Title IX: Students have the option to report and/or participate in a voluntary internal campus investigation. The Office of Civil Rights & Title IX also provides internal measures for students (academic assistance, housing accommodations) without reporting.
- Care Coordinator: Provides confidential and free individualized support for all students affected by sexual and domestic violence and assists with navigating campus and community resources.
- Community Advocacy: Organizes confidential resources including therapy, advocacy and safe shelter are available through the Care Center (Sexual Assault) and the Willow (Intimate Partner Violence).
- Counseling: No and low cost therapeutic resources for both acute and historical assault are available on and off campus.
